At age eleven, I gave my life to Christ. I lived daily to honor him and knew that if I devoted my life to him, I would be blessed with an abundant life and have life everlasting. I joined Second Baptist Church of Kalamazoo, Michigan, as I served diligently as president of the usher board for over 30 plus years under the leadership of the belated Rev. Matthew Wright. My beloved ushers were not only my brothers and sisters in Christ, but I considered them family. As I became a senior citizen, the importance of worshipping with my family became a priority for me. I ended my tenure at Second Baptist Church, and

transferred my membership to Mount Zion Baptist Church of Kalamazoo, Michigan, where my Pastor is Rev. Dr. Addis Moore. This is the church where my son Allen and daughter Ormon are members. Oh what a joy it is to worship the Lord with your children.
