



Mother Catherine Ruth White

July 23, 1924 - November 15, 2013

Mother Catherine R. White was born to the union of John and Myrtle Coleman, Sr. on July 23, 1924 in Beloit, WS. She was the second oldest of four children. She graduated from Beloit High School. The family relocated to Kalamazoo, where she met and married Albert L. White in 1942. They had two daughters, Donna and Pam.

Mother White received Christ at an early age and exemplified His heart and hands throughout her lifetime. She shared and instilled her belief in Christ with her family and the many lives she touched.

Greater Faith Fellowship Church recognized that she was a pioneer and trailblazer and awarded her for outstanding service and dedication. She served the church as a trustee, choir president, organist and minister of music, as well as a missionary and certified evangelist.

Her professional career was at Michigan Bell. She was the first Black service representative, then became manager of Personnel and retired as the Assistant Manager of Corporate Affairs.

She contributed to her community in many ways. Among her accomplishments are the following: she received the NAACP Merit Award, was YWCA President and Executive Board Member, B'Nai Brith Woman of

the Year, Davenport College Advisory Board Member and received outstanding recognition for contributions to the D.E. and Office Co-Op Program.

Early in the morning on Friday, November 15, 2013 she departed this life after a long illness. She was preceded in death by her parents and two siblings: John Coleman, Sr. and Jaquetta Starr.

Surviving are two daughters: Donna White-Ward (Cedric) of Kalamazoo, MI and Pam Logan (George) of Kansas City, MO; a brother, Donald Coleman (Vickie) of Baltimore, MD; three grandchildren, Whitney Townes, Traysi White and Cliff Julian; six great-grandchildren, six great- great grandchildren, and a host of nieces, nephews, extended family and friends.
