Charles Russell Powell, age 72, also known to many as "Ajax", passed away suddenly and unexpectedly on Tuesday, March 21, 2017. He was born December 16, 1944 in Trenton, TN to William F. Powell and Rebecca Elder Powell. He was educated in the Rosenwald School System. Upon graduation he moved to Kalamazoo, MI and enlisted in the United States Navy (Vietnam Era).

After being honorably discharged from the Navy, he began to work for the Eckrich Meat Company. Charles left Eckrich to begin a career with the General Motors Corporation, ultimately retiring from the Lansing Assembly Plant as a Team Leader after 37 years of service. He was also a member of Local 652 and a former member of Local 488.

Charles joined Galilee Baptist Church under the leadership of former Pastor Rev. Dr. J. Louis Felton. He was a member of Central Lodge #10 of the Affiliated Free and Accepted Mason, Kalamazoo Chapter. He was also a member of the former American Legion Post 134.

Charles enjoyed playing Pinochle and other cards with his friends as well as gardening. He grew the best and the biggest tomatoes around!. He was a family man and his greatest joy was spending time with his children and grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his parents; a brother, Robert L. Powell; a sister Diane Powell and a very special brother-in-law, Calvin Howard.

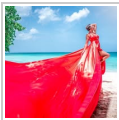

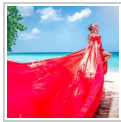

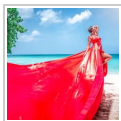
