Cherise Antoinette Jennings was born on September 12, 1962 in Chicago Illinois to the late Marshall and Icelean Ellington. As the daughter of a missionary and deacon, Cherise accepted Christ at an early age and lived her life declaring the works of the Lord.

After graduating from Allegan Senior High School, Cherise worked for Hart and Cooley Factory for 10 years before starting her own business, Accessories Plus Boutique in the City of Allegan. As one of the first African American boutique owners in the city, Cherise proudly dressed everyone who entered her doors from prom attendees, to brides, to church mothers looking for suits and hats that would not only turn heads but demand attention.

Cherise spent 26 years with the love of her life, her devoted husband Rickey Lee Jennings. The two were united in matrimony on October 7, 1995 and would have celebrated their 18 year anniversary.

As the mother of 9 children, Cherise was no stranger to accepting tough challenges with a courageous spirit, after being stricken with blindness in 2010. Cherise went on to attend Cornerstone University, where she pursued a degree in Business Management.

In her spare time, Cherise enjoyed shopping, watching movies, studying the

bible and spending time with her family. In 2005, Cherise became an ordained licensed Evangelist Missionary in the Church of God in Christ and declared that she would forever spread the word that, "Jesus was coming soon".

Upon being diagnosed with stage 4 breast cancer, Cherise stayed strong in her faith and never gave up the belief that God was able.

Cherise was preceded in death by her father, Marshall Ellington; her mother, Icelean Ellington and her father-in-law, Administrator Walter Jennings.

Cherise's life will remain alive through her loving and devoted husband, Rickey Jennings of Allegan MI; 6 sons: Alfonzo, Harrison, Artelle all of Allegan MI, Dwayne of Holland MI, Jaquan of Kalamazoo MI and Lamare of Kalamazoo MI; 3 daughters: Oviance of Allegan MI; Octaivia of Battle Creek MI and Helen of Los Angeles, CA; 3 sisters, Nadean Horton of Chicago, IL, Margret Ellington of Kalamazoo MI and Maureen (Carol) Ellington of Holland MI; mother-in-law, Bernice Jennings of Kalamazoo MI; 4 grandchildren; along with a host of relatives and friends.
