He honorably served his country in the Vietnam War, earning numerous commendations including the National Defense Service Medal, Vietnam Campaign Medal with device, Vietnam Service Medal with three stars, Combat Action Ribbon, Rifle Marksman Badge, and the Purple Heart with one star.

Fred had an unwavering passion for music and a deep commitment to bringing joy to others. Known to many as DJ Sweetback, he made a lasting impression everywhere he went-whether cruising around town with music blasting or lighting up dance floors and events across Michigan, Illinois, Texas, Washington, and Missouri. His love for music wasn't just a hobby; it was a lifelong mission to connect, uplift, and entertain.

Beyond his resilience and strength, Fred's true legacy lies in his capacity to love. He had a gift for making people feel seen, heard, and valued. No matter the circumstance, he made it a priority to share laughter, kindness, and warmth with those around him.

Fred is survived by his beloved children: Juanita, Sophia, Frederick, and Alexander. He also leaves behind 16 cherished grandchildren and 15 great-grandchildren, his siblings, Gertrude, Beverly, James, Willie, Larry, and Micheal, extended family, and a host of cousins and friends whose lives were brighter because of him.
