Once again, it is with overwhelming sadness, but also with an assured confidence in Jesus Christ, that we celebrate the life of our beloved, JaSheika Monique Glass, who was affectionately called "Sheika" by all who knew and loved her.

A devoted and caring mother to her loving children, Billy and Laila, the beloved only daughter of her mother, Rita; a beautiful and loving cousin, an amazing niece, a caring granddaughter, and a loyal and true friend, JaSheika Monique Glass tragically departed this life on Friday, August 2, 2024, in Kalamazoo, Michigan, in an automobile accident.

The beautiful mortal life of JaSheika Monique Glass was born into time on Sunday, June 14, 1981, at the former Memorial Hospital which is now Corewell Lakeland Health Center South in St. Joseph, Michigan, to her beautiful parents, the late Gregory Allan Glass and Rita Glass. When her friends were asked to describe “Sheika” or “Ja” as some called her, they said that she was a very giving and caring person. She was deeply spiritual and loved God, dependable, funny, charismatic, strong-willed, opinionated, determined and the epitome of love and if you met her once, she left an indelible footprint in your life, one that you would never forget.

As a mother, “Sheika” was so excited when she found out she was going to become a mother at the age of twenty-eight. She was loving and giving, their protector and their provider, and she always made sure that they had whatever they needed Billy and Laila

were always her number one priority and she made sure that they both had a loving and nurturing relationship with her because she wanted them to always know that they were loved like she was unconditionally loved by her mother until the end of her life on this earth.

On the day she passed away, she never stopped being a loving mother. She took Billy to get a tattoo in honor of his 16th birthday and the tattoo he chose read, "I AM MY MOTHER'S KEEPER". God Is A Good God...She will truly be missed and loved by her children.

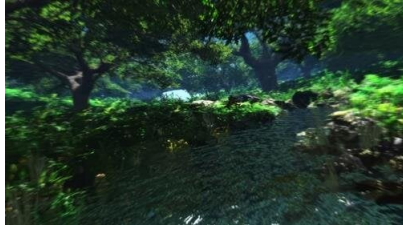
