I miss the kids running around and watching cartoons in the morning slightly irritated because Ana woke them up at 7 inthe morning, or your smart comments about every possible thing. I just hope you know now how many people

love you, miss you, and pray until their knees are sore for you to come back. I hope you are at peace now. I hope you are smiling down on us all, and most of all I hope we can all see you again.... My only hope and wish is that you have found the peace you needed. We will all see you soon.
