John Edward Jackson passed away on January 1, 2020 at 11:05 a.m., with his wife, Carrie Jackson by his bedside at Rose Arbor Hospice Residence in Kalamazoo, MI at the young age of 56. John was diagnosed with a rare and untreatable cancer on November 27, 2019 and fought every day to beat the disease with a continued hold of strong faith in the Lord. John also suffered a stroke during this time and continued to fight every day. He had a strong support system by his side 24 hours a day which consisted of his wife Carrie, son Tray, and his daughter Laila who never left his side. John also had many visits from his family, church family and friends.

John was born on July 16, 1963 in Belzoni Mississippi to Louise Jackson and Odies Van Willis. He and his family moved to Chicago, IL when John was a young boy where he attended Albert Einstein Elementary School. John then attended Farragut Career Academy High School until he graduated in 1983. He was an All American in Basketball, Football and Swimming. John worked for the Chicago Park District in Chicago, IL during his years in high school.

In 1990, John moved to Michigan and united in marriage to Carrie Jackson and to this union two children were born, Tray Ali Jackson and Laila Rosa Jackson. In 2010, he chose to move his family to the suburbs of Chicago, IL

where he attended Harper College in Palatine, IL for Coaching. In 2013, John and his family moved to Portage, MI where John attended Kalamazoo Community College for Entrepreneurship and Business to start his own company, Real Property Solutions.

John joined First United Baptist Church in Kalamazoo, MI in 2014; under the leadership of Pastor Lenzy E. Bell and First Lady Lori Ann Bell. He was a part of the Men's Choir, Mass Choir and the New Beginning's Choir. John also became a Trustee of the church in 2016.

John was a devoted, loyal, honest, kind-hearted, loving, protective and faith carrying Husband, Father, Son, Brother, Uncle, Cousin and Friend. He was not afraid to speak his mind and tell it how it was. If you didn't want to hear the truth, then it should not have been said or done around John, because his honesty and integrity would step in with his mercy and grace and tell you how it was going to be done! John's heart was so big that he was there for everyone day or night, whenever they needed him. He always made sure that everyone was comfortable and well fed! John also made sure that his wife and children as well as himself had the best of everything. He also made sure his wife and children, as well as himself, were dressed and smelling good at all times! John did not believe in half-steppin'! John loved sports, especially Chicago Sports. He made sure he was able to watch all Bulls, Bears and Cubs games. 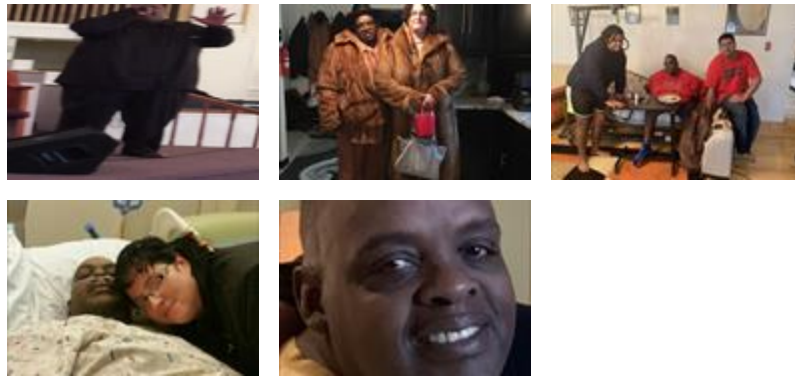
