Larry Moore went home to be with the Lord September 14, 2012 in Kalamazoo, MI. He was born the son of Willie D. Moore and Selessie Winters October 29, 1951 in Kennett, MO. He was the 5th child of 16 sisters and brothers. In 1955, Larry moved with his family to Michigan. He was baptized at an early age. Although Larry was not a member of a church in Kalamazoo, he did attend Morning Star Baptist Church in Eau Claire, MI.

Larry married Bernice Hunt of Dowagiac, MI and to this union a daughter, Shanise Moore was born. Larry relocated to Kalamazoo, MI when he was in his early 20's and met Henrietta Reed with two sons born to this union, James Reed and Larry Moore, Jr.

Larry was employed with Checker Motor Auto Company for over 35 years. He retired from there when the company closed their doors in 2006, which was at the onset of his struggle with a seizure disorder.

Larry was preceded in death by his father, Willie D. Moore and his brother, Fred Lee Moore.

Larry was known to many as the "Cassopolis Kid". His son, James remembers the countless back roads his dad took him through in the country and long talks teaching him how to be a man. Larry is gone now, but will never be

forgotten.
