Mrs. Lillie Mae Jackson passed away on Saturday, November 25, 2017 at Medilodge of Portage. Lillie was born on February 6, 1927 the daughter of Reverend Frank and Irene Edmonds of Starkville, Mississippi. She accepted Jesus Christ as her Savior at her father's church, at a young age.

Lillie relocated her family to Kalamazoo, Michigan with the support of her sister Liney in the early 1960's, where she raised all nine of her children. Lillie enjoyed being a strong support system to her children.

She completed her high school degree from Kalamazoo Central Adult High School. She later became employed by Bronson Methodist Hospital, where she worked in the Central Service Department for 27 years, until she retired in 1993.

After retirement, she dedicated the majority of her time caring for her youngest daughter Angela, who had been ill for many years with sickle cell disease.

Lillie also did volunteer work at the Kalamazoo Civic Theatre. She was a long time member of Second Baptist Church in Kalamazoo, MI, where she served on the Usher Board. She also enjoyed attending regular bible studies at her church, until her health declined.

Lillie was preceded in death by her husband, Wesley Jackson; 4 of her cherished children: 3 daughters, Helen Anthony, Maelene Jackson, Angela Jackson; and 1 son, Ronald Jackson; a sister Liney Mae Canady and her only brother, Frank Edmonds, Jr.

Lillie leaves to cherish her memories of Godly Wisdom and Unconditional Love to her 5 children: 4 daughters, Janice Cobb and Sondra Brooks both of Kalamazoo, MI; Kaye Cullins (Harry) of Leesburg, Virginia, Demetra Jennings (Charles) of Douglasville, GA; 1 son, Wesley Bernard Jackson of Inglewood, CA; 3 sisters, Shirley Bridges (James); Rena Williams (Gene); Lois Glass (George). Lillie is the proud grandmother of 20 grandchildren,

50 great-grandchildren and 7 great-great grandchildren. She will truly be missed by her family, friends and her Second Baptist Church family.

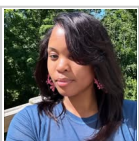
