Mary L. McCants was born March 5, 1926 to the union of Willie and Fannie Mae Jones in Thomaston, Georgia. Mary was the 5th of nine children. As a young girl, Mary confessed her commitment to the Lord Jesus Christ. Mary was educated in the Thomaston and Upson County Schools. In 1945, Mary married Charlie E. McCants. The following year Charlie and Mary blessed with the birth of their son, Charles Edward McCants. In 1947, Mary and her family relocated to Kalamazoo, Michigan. After their arrival in Kalamazoo, Charlie and Mary were blessed by the arrival of their only daughter Mivis and youngest son Dennis.

Upon her arrival Kalamazoo, Mary joined Second Baptist Church under the leadership of Pastor Warfield. She was a faithful member of the choir, missionary society culinary committee, and served many times as chairperson of it's women's day and the Pastor's anniversary. Nothing illustrated her love more than the beautiful flowers she planted around the ground of the church.
