Mr. George Shelton left this world in the early morning of May 20, 2008. He left behind a loving and devoted family, a close knit circle of friends, a large group of people that liked him as soon as they met him and a world that was a better place with him active in it. George was born on August 16, 1942 in Tomo, Arkansas, the son of Lawrence Shelton and Mary Drinks. A cat lover and a mischievous child, there were many mishaps including crashing his older brother's car on prom night. After he graduated from Cassopolis High School in 1960, he joined the Army. He was discharged from the Army in 1964. It wasn't until the seventies, well into the disco era, that his life took a dramatic turn: he met his future wife, Sandra, and they were later married on September 18, 1978. Two years later, the family was complete when their ten year old Jimmy would have a younger sister, named Erin. George and Sandra remained happily married through unemployment, bonus checks, through fights and arguments and through sickness and in health, until his untimely passing.

He is survived by his beloved wife Sandra; his two children, Erin and James; his sister and brother-in-law, Maxine and Henry McNary; his brother, Lawrence Shelton; two grandchildren, Zoe and Zachary, numerous nieces and nephews, well-loved friends and his co-workers at Perrigo. Finally, let it be known that no one can replace the beloved husband and father who rescued cats; listened to music and watched television at the same time;

squashed insects; guarded his wife's garden from bunnies, snakes and squirrels; gave his daughter a hard time about not seeing a hair stylist; secured the house every night before going to bed and loved eating Cheerios. May his spirit rest in peace while enjoying lemonade spritzers, baby back ribs and Breyers vanilla ice cream.
