Mr. Herman A. Stewart Jr. passed away Saturday, May 15, 2010 in Kalamazoo, MI. Mr. Stewart was born October 27, 1919 in Battle Creek, MI, the son of Herman A. Stewart, Sr. and Mayme Lee (Whitby) Stewart. At the age of 22 years, he enlisted into the Army, where he served as a Corporal, in Company D, 94th Engineer Regiment, until receiving an Honorable Discharge four years later, on March 22, 1945. He was united in marriage on December 21, 1954 to Wilma Stewart. Herman worked for the United States Postal Service for many years, retiring in 1980. He was a devoted member of The Galilee Baptist Church, for many years, and was involved in the Brotherhood ministry. Herman was a very kind and giving person. He always had a smile on his face. He truly loved people and it showed through his generosity-- always ready and willing to help others. He often would visit area nursing homes to encourage the residents who lived there. He enjoyed volunteering every year to greet elementary students on their first day of the school. Herman will truly be missed by family, friends, and all of those who loved him.
