Mr. Houston Dunigan departed his life March 3, 2009 at Borgess Hospital. Houston was born November 26, 1915 in Okolona Mississippi, to the late George and Callie (Burdine) Dunigan. He was a resident of Kalamazoo since 1940.

Houston accepted Christ as his savior at Mt. Zion Baptist Church, here in Kalamazoo, where he served as a Deacon, trustee, Treasurer, and he was a member of the Christian Education Department, as well as the 2000 "Man of the Year". Houston was employed at Allied Steel where he retired, then became Self Employed.
