Mr. John R. Green, Jr. was born in Bangor, MI on November 22, 1933 to John, Sr. and Mabel (West) Green. He was one of 2 children born to this union. John was joined in marriage to Leontine Staten, and celebrated 48 years together. To this union brought together eleven (11) children. He departed this life at the age of 75 on Thursday, September 10, 2009; at his home in Kalamazoo, MI.

John served in the United States Navy from 1951-1954. He received several medals and commendations for his duty during that Korean War. He served in the inactive Naval Reserves from 1954-1959.

John held the position of Administrative Vice President with the Mailhandlers Union Local 307, State of Michigan from 1972 to 1992. In 1992, he held the position of State Representative with the Mailhandlers Union Local 307, State of Michigan. He later retired from the United States Postal Service in October 1992, after 29 years of working as a U.S. Postal Worker.

Over the years John worked numerous part-time jobs to provide extra support for his family. These included 25 years for the Kalamazoo Gazette and 9 years for DeNooyer Chevrolet. John is preceded in death by his parents, John Sr. and Mabel (West) Green; one brother, John (Corrine) Green, and one son-in-law, David Ri'Chard.

He leaves to cherish his memory his loving wife of 48 years, Leontine (Staten) Green; one brother, Edwin (Catherine) Green; one sister, Phyllis Greene; 11 children, Teri (Ralph) Jackson, Kathryn Redsky, Darryl (Beverly) Green,

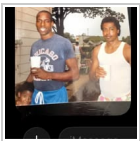

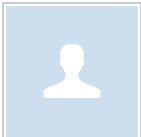

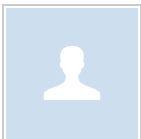
