In Geiger, Alabama, Inez Densmore gave birth to her only son, Leroy Evins on January 5, 1923. Leroy was raised in a small family (with sister Alicesteen and mom) that his mother led by her faith in Christ. The naturally quiet natured Leroy was an attentive observer and listener. It is literally "no wonder" that while growing into adulthood, he too, developed unfailing faith in Christianity. Of all the ways he practiced this commitment, he told his granddaughter that serving as a Sunday School Teacher (as a young father) was what he found most rewarding. In EVERY endeavor of his life, Leroy consistently demonstrated his dedication to duty, discipline and diligence. Whether in service to our country (as a member of the National Coast Guard from 1943 to 1945) or in guiding and providing for his family. The god-given qualities illuminated the manner which he gave himself to the purpose of his involvement: family, employment and ministry. Leroy worked in many settings before ultimately retiring from his position as a Security Guard for the National Bank of Detroit. He often held two jobs at once to provide for his family of five children that he had with teenaged sweetheart and wife, Jessie Mae Hanks. When their 27 yr. marriage ended he remarried. Leroy adopted an additional child, Dotian, with his second wife, Dories. Leroy remains admired and appreciated for the model he set for living by the values of self-respect, carrying oneself with dignity, never daring to judge others, to always remember the Sabbath and keep it holy and to first honor and obey the Will of the Lord. He will forever be loved and missed by his surviving family: his

sister, Alicesteen; children, Leroy Jr. Charllotte, Yvette, Mark and Lisa; 12 grandchildren, and a host of extended family member. We will always love our Daddy, Brother, Uncle, Grandpa and Friend.
