March 10, 1915 - June 3, 2008

Ida Bell Davis, wife of the late Elder William Davis, was welcomed by heaven's gates on June 3, 2008. Ida was born March 10, 1915 in Prairie Point, Mississippi to the parents of Willie and Maggie (White) Winston. William "Mack" Davis found the love of his life and he and Ida wed in 1931. Looking to improve their lives, William and Ida moved to Kalamazoo, Michigan in 1951 where they served the Lord in several ministries. Ida initially joined Mount Zion Baptist Church and was a founding member of Friendship Baptist Church and Galilee Baptist Church. At Galilee Baptist Church she served in many ministries and was the first recording secretary for the church. She was the co-founder of Tower of Faith Church.
