(Hogan) Price. She was the fifth child of eleven born to this union; she graduated from Christianburg High School, Christianburg, VA and accepted Christ at an early age at First Baptist Church of Magazine Street, Pulaski, VA. On July 4, 1942 she was united in holy matrimony to Herman Hoston who preceded her in passing. To this union she was blessed with three children. In 1947 they moved to South Bend, Indiana. She united with Pilgrim Missionary Baptist Church approximately 60 years ago where she served on the Mamie Bingham Missionary Society, in the kitchen and as a representative for Church Women United. She was also a coach for the Junior Bowling Association; Girl Scout Leader; an Avon Representative and President's Club Member for over 20 years. She was the last living member of the Peppyettes.
