Mrs. Omeria L. Bostic departed this life, Sunday, May 25, 2008. Mrs. Bostic was born on October 29, 1924 the only child of Drucilla and Mr. Dempsey of Hope, Arkansas. After graduating from high school Omeria met and married Charles Cefus Bostic in 1945. They had their first child in Arkansas, before moving to Kalamazoo, Michigan in 1946. While living in Kalamazoo, Omeria would give birth to nine more children. During her first several years of residency in Kalamzoo, Omeria was a dedicated homemaker, raising her children and keeping her home in order and clean. In addition to being a dedicated homemaker, Mrs. Bostic was dedicated to her church, The Galilee Baptist Church. She was involved in church activities and always made sure her children attended church on Sunday mornings. In the mid sixties, Mrs. Bostic was hired by the Lockshore Company, where she worked for several years. While at Lockshore's, she made many friends and acquaintances. She was considered by many patrons as a kind, considerate and loving person. AFter leaving Lockshore Company, Omeria worked for the Borrough's Corporation and Gilmore's as a Secretary. She also attneded Kalamazoo Valley Community College, where she completed her Associate's Degree. In the late seventies, Omeria went to work for the Upjohn Company and also went into the rental business as a Landlord. Omeria retired from Upjohn-Pharmacia in 1991. After retirement, she continued to work as a Landlord. Omeria Bostic is preceded in death by her husband of 40 years, Charles Bostic; children, Katheryn Hobson, Charles Bostic Jr., Desirea Bostic, Derrick

Bostic and Jacqueline Bostic.

She leaves to cherish her memory: her surviving children, Joan Thompkins, Diane Stovall, Sheila Slater, Karen Taliaferro and Paul Bostic. She is also survived by many grandchildren and great-grandchildren.
