After graduating from Covert High School, Bill attended Western Michigan University for 3 years and then enlisted in the Air force. While attending Western Michigan University he joined Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity Incorporated Gamma Beta Chapter.

While stationed in Las Vegas, Nevada, Bill met and married Shirley Johnson, and to this union a son was, Brian, was born. Upon his honorable discharge from servicing in the military Bill and his family relocated to Inkster, Michigan.
