This transition provided the opportunity for young Sparkle to excel in the Kalamazoo Public School System and earn the necessary credits to complete her high school courses ahead of schedule and graduate from Kalamazoo Central High School in 1972. Sparkle was a dedicated and bright student with ample ambition. She also attended Western Michigan University and earned a degree in business and she received a degree in Cosmetology. Sparkle became a member of Galilee Baptist Church as a young girl. Sparkle retired as an employee of Kalamazoo County on October 7, 2009, where she served as Supervisor at the Ministry with Community Homeless Shelter for nearly two decades. Sparkle took great pride during her tenure with the shelter helping recipients achieve goals and objectives, re-establishing homesteads, and a sense of well-being. Sparkle was blessed with two loving sons: Quintin and Tyson Brown, whom both survive her passing; and are two loving fathers to Sparkles four grandsons: Quintin, Tykese, Quibin and Isaiah; and two granddaughters: Morgan and Kennedy and two goddaughters: Ladayshia Brown and Ashley Gordon.
