



Pastor Amos Junior Williams

February 13, 1953 - February 4, 2009

Dr. Amos Junior Williams of Flint Township, died at home after a long battle with cancer. Amos was born on February 13, 1953 in Kalamazoo, MI. He was the first born child of Pastor Amos Sr. and Mabel Williams. Amos was a graduate of Kalamazoo Central High School in 1971. Shortly before finishing his Bachelor's of Science Degree from Western University in 1981, Amos married Janet Nunnally on September 6, 1980. He received a concurrent Masters in Theology and Doctorate of Philosophy and Biblical Studies, and Theology in December 2008. Amos was a lifelong learner. Over the years, he received numerous certificates in various fields including Management, Engineering and Chemistry. He also was a licensed builder and insurance agent. He was a supervisor and trainer retiring from Delphi automotive in 2008. Amos lived throughout Michigan. As a husband and father, he moved from Kalamazoo to Wyandotte, Ypsilanti and finally to Flint to provide for his family. He was passionate about music and was known as "The Music Man" As an accomplished guitarist he traveled throughout the United States sharing his gift. He also recorded music with his wife, Janet N. Williams in the 80's. In 1998, he accepted the call of God and accepted a pastoral appointment under the direction and leadership of Bishop John Sheard; Jurisdictional Bishop of Southwest #1, to lead the congregation of Greater Faith in Muskegon, MI. He was a faithful pastor and served God's people with his time, talent, and spiritual wealth. He loved the "Grand Ole, Church of God in Christ". Amos was a giver and a mighty man of valor and integrity. As a pastor, he made the word

real to the congregation. He diligently poured into the lives of God's people. He made the word relevant and applicable for the youngest to the oldest members. He valued people and taught his members that God had a plan for their lives. Throughout his life he served God's people and had a special love for the disenfranchised. He served the Church of God in Christ as a Marshall in the national church. In Dr. Amos Junior Williams' last stages of life, he experienced no pain. In his words he would say Bishop Goldsberry's saying, "THE DEVIL IS A LIAR, FOR I BELIEVE GOD, JESUS IS HERE, and I'M GONNA HAVE JUST WHAT I WANT. BY THE POWER, AND THE AUTHORITY, AND THE ABILITY OF THE ALMIGHTY GOD, AND IN THE NAME OF JESUS, AND BY THE FAITH OF THE SON OF GOD, IT SHALL BE DONE!
