The Obituary

Ralph Stewart transitioned to be with his Lord and Savior on November 10, 2020 at Ascension Borgess Hospital in Kalamazoo, Michigan. He was the first born child of Annie Jean Stewart on June 17, 1968 in Chicago, IL. Ralph attended Bloomtrail High School and graduated in 1986. He received a football scholarship to attend Eastern Illinois University and went on to play

with their football team from 1986 to 1990, at the WR position.

He received All American Honorable Mention. In 1991, Ralph served in the United States Army as a Second Lt. Quarter Master Branch (Supply). His responsibilities were to oversee all transportation movement, refueling operations and leadership of all troops in a company.

Ralph was employed for many years at Ford Motor Company in Chicago, as a Material Handling Superintendent and also worked at various other jobs. He later took a position at Post Cereal in Battle Creek, MI where he worked in a supervision role, which he loved until his untimely passing.

Ralph loved the Lord and joined Galilee Baptist Church under the leadership of Pastor Dr. Michael T. Scott, Sr. serving in the Transportation Ministry.

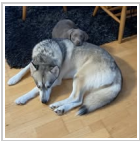
