Robert F. Moore, Jr. ("Preacher"), 66, returned to his heavenly home on Monday, June 4th, 2018 after a valiant battle with a long illness. His devotion to his family and his firm belief in God supported him in his struggle and ultimately gave him peace.

Robert was born to the late Robert, Sr. and Hattie Moore in Mobile (Prichard) Alabama on October 17, 1951. He accepted Christ at an early age and attended his father's church, Washington Memorial A.O.H. Church of God. As a young man he relocated to Kalamazoo, Michigan where he pursued a career as a Machinist at General Motors. Robert also attended Western Michigan University for a degree in Engineering. While working for GM, he enlisted into the United States Navy, where he served as a Petty Officer Machinist in Aviation from 1976-1979.
