THE OBITUARY

Susan attended Comstock Public Schools and during her years participated in many sports (basketball, tennis, soccer) and other extracurricular activities. Volleyball became her passion. She was a lead player in high school, helping the Colts win three state titles. She was inducted into Comstock High School's Hall of Fame in April 2025. She played division one volleyball at the University of Minnesota, was inducted into their Hall of Fame and graduated with a bachelor's degree.

Susan continued her volleyball career, playing professionally overseas in Belgium and the Netherlands.

Susan and DuWayne met in 2001 and were married in Kalamazoo on September 1, 2007. September 1st is also Albert Jackson's birthday. From this union two beautiful children, Jackson (14) and Payton (12), were born.

Susan earned her master's degree at Concordia University St. Paul, MN, where she also worked as an Adjunct Professor, focusing on Differential Education and Special Education. She did this while homeschooling Jackson and Payton.

The aforementioned achievements are beyond impressive; her greatest joy is investing with DuWayne in the spiritual, cultural, and educational well-being of their children. This included several job-related relocation opportunities across the US, and an expat assignment in Bengaluru, India.

In May of 2021, Susan inspired the effort to move closer to family. This determination led to her immediate family relocating to Kalamazoo, where they built and moved into a home she designed.
