THE OBITUARY

Mr. William Linstrom Hodge passed away peacefully at Borgess Gardens Nursing Facility on July 30, 2022 at the age of 102. William, who was affectionately called Bill, was born January 4, 1920 in Vicksburg, Mississippi to the late John and Bertha (Green) Hodge. After graduating high school and attending college, he spent several years in the army, reaching the rank of Corporal; he was honorably discharged in 1943. He met his wife, Nancy Belle Lewis, while he was stationed in Columbia, Georgia. They married in 1943 and then relocated to Kalamazoo. To this union, three children were born, Vincent Conrad, Carolyn Elizabeth and Larry Linstrom.

Soon after arriving in Kalamazoo, Mr. Hodge enrolled at Western Michigan University and received a Bachelor's Degree in Speech Pathology. He later obtained Master's degrees in both Business and Accounting. Mr. Hodge became a certified public accountant for the State of Michigan and had the distinction of being one of the first African Americans to work in this capacity. He retired after a successful career of close to 30 years. After retirement, he enjoyed doing financial planning for individuals.

Mr. Hodge was a member of Second Baptist Church for many years. He eventually transferred his membership to Mt. Zion Baptist Church where he was a very faithful member until his health began to fail. He was very involved in the Kalamazoo community where he served on numerous boards and committees. He also has been a Life Member of the NAACP for many years. Bill had several hobbies, but his passion, though, was playing golf. People still consider him one of the finest golfers that ever lived in the Kalamazoo area. He has also received recognition on both the state and national levels. He took great pride in knowing that he was one of the golfers that was instrumental in

breaking racial barriers in golf in this area. He was very proud of the fact that he was one of the original members of the Mall City Golf League, a league formed in 1985, that consisted of African American men. He had fond memories and respect for the great men that were part of this prestigious league.

Besides his parents, Bill was preceded in death by his siblings, Johnnie Hodge, Doris Washington, Ernest Hodge and Sandy Hodge. His son, Larry, also preceded him in death.

In addition to his children, Mr. Hodge leaves to cherish his memory eleven grandchildren, Vincent, Jr., Portia Robin, Sasha Elizabeth, Zita Nancy, Ihsan Karim, Yasmin Rahimah, Isa Najm, Aliyah Malaika, Ibrahim Jabril, Salim and Anastatia; several great grandchildren, Anthony, Elijah, Olivia, Kaden, Zaria, Kai, and Bailey and a host of nieces, nephew, cousins and friends.

Mr. William Hodge will be sorely missed, but his legacy will live on in the memories of his dear family and friends.

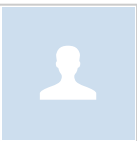
